HOW MUCH ARE TICKETS AND WHERE CAN I BUY THEM?

In advance before Thursday 29th August

Adult Weekend £30 per adult 18 years plus (Friday 5:00pm – Sunday 5:00pm). £40 with camping Friday to Sunday.

Child Weekend with Complementary Camping Free with a paying Adult Age 5 – 18 years. One child per paying adult.

Under 5s Free.

Additional 5 – 18 year olds £5 for the weekend.

On the Door 30th August to 1st June

Prices to be announced nearer the festival date.

Daily Tickets

Adults in Advance £10 per day

Child in Advance Free one per adult

Additional children £2 per child in advance

On the Door

To be announced nearer the festival date.

Tickets are non refundable.

CAN I GET A DISCOUNT ON TICKETS?

The only discount available is by purchasing tickets in advance of the festival weekend.

WHEN & HOW WILL I RECEIVE MY TICKETS?

You will receive an email confirmation following successful online payment. Please retain this email! THIS IS YOUR PROOF OF PURCHASE. Either print it out or show the email when you enter the TICKET CONTROL AT THE FESTIVAL. You

CAN I PAY FOR MY TICKET IN INSTALMENTS?

Parking & Camping

1. CAN I BRING A CARAVAN / CAMPERVAN?

We have limited space for Caravans and Campervans and these will need to be pre booked by email to info@tcrhub.co.uk. The cost to park is £5 per day.

2. WILL THERE BE SHOWER FACILITIES?

We will have a range of portable showers available.

3. WILL THERE BE A 'QUIET' CAMPING ZONE?

We hope that all camping areas will be quiet zones as we are aiming the festival at families. Anyone who wishes to party later into the night will be advised to stick around the fire pit area near the Hub building and away from the camp site.

4. WILL THERE BE PHONE CHARGING FACILITIES?

We regret to inform you that at present we cannot offer phone charging services for ticket holders. This is because we have a small venue and do not have the funds to support this facility. We will look into this for future festivals.

5. DO I HAVE TO PAY FOR PARKING?

Parking is £5 per vehicle per day. Parking is limited. You will need to book this with your ticket if you know you will require it on the day.

6. HOW FAR IS THE CAR PARK FROM THE CAMPSITE?

A five-minute walk along flat ground.

7. WHAT TIME DOES THE CAMPSITE OPEN?

The campsite will open at 3:00pm on Friday 30th August along with the carpark. The venue will be accessible at this time too although the timetable of activities does not begin until 5:00pm.

8. WHAT TIME CAN WE ARRIVE ON SITE?

You may arrive on site from 3:00pm on Friday 30th August.

9. WILL THERE BE A MAIN STAGE?

We have a main studio where we will be hosting a variety of live music. Music is not the main feature of the event but compliments all the other wonderful things going on!

10. WHAT HAPPENS ON THE SUNDAY?

All activities will finish by 4:00pm on Sunday and the campsite will be closed by 6:00pm. The carpark closes at 6:00pm and must be completely cleared. Any vehicles left will be towed away.

Accessibility & Restrictions

1. WILL I NEED TO BRING I.D.?

You will be asked for ID if you look under 25 years and wish to purchase alcohol at the bar. Tickets are non transferable and you may be asked for ID to prove that the ticket you hold is yours.

2. ARE TEENAGERS ALLOWED, IF ACCOMPANIED BY A RESPONSIBLE ADULT?

All children must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Any unaccompanied teenagers will be asked to leave the site if they cannot prove they are with an adult.

3. ARE DOGS ALLOWED AT THE FESTIVAL?

Well behaved dogs are allowed on site but please be respectful of all tickets holders. Misbehaving dogs and their owners will be asked to leave the premises!

4. CAN I BRING MY OWN ALCOHOL?

You may bring your own alcohol into the campsite, but you will not be permitted to bring it into the Hub building and main grounds. Anyone who is found to be bringing their own alcohol in to the building or main grounds will have their items confiscated and may be asked to leave the site. Our bars are reasonably priced and all proceeds go towards the charity the TCR Hub.

5. WHAT IS YOUR DISABILITY ACCESS POLICY?

Our access policy can be found on our website. The Hub is fully accessible although we only have a very limited capacity for disabled access to the main stage each evening and disabled parking must be pre booked by emailing info@tcrhub.co.uk. You are very welcome to speak to us beforehand to discuss your needs.

6. CAN I BRING A CAMPING CHAIR INTO THE FESTIVAL ARENA?

Yes you can bring camping chairs and tables on the camp field and you can bring them into the main grounds but there is not sufficient space to bring them into the main studios.

Music & Festival

All live music will start by 6:00pm and finish by 10:30pm.
