

Guidance for a Successful Anti- Litter Bug Pick!

- Do not enter restricted areas such as road works or where the public do not have the right to enter • Litter picking next to a road- stay on the verges, pavements and always face oncoming traffic • It is requested that you wear a hi-vis jacket to ensure you can be seen by road users- not to do so is entirely at your own risk!
- Do not attempt to clear litter from roads • Avoid reaching under hedges in a way that may expose your eyes/ face/ skin to come into contact with sharp branches /thorns
- Avoid working directly next to rivers, fast flowing or deep water
- Be careful when collecting rubbish from sloped or uneven ground
- Stick together! Avoid picking alone and ensure you have a mobile phone with you in case of emergencies • Please do not pick up any drugs paraphernalia but do report it to use so we can inform the council to come and remove it
- If in doubt, don't pick it up. Any large quantity of broken glass, please leave and again report it to us • Be mindful of wildlife
- If you can't reach it with your picker, leave it-don't over reach!
